do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peter J. Sasso, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL THE RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST of the Grantor herein in and to that
portion, not heretofore conveyed, of the properties more particularly
described in the deed from A. C. Justus and S. L. Jones to Gradie L.
Floyd, Carl Floyd, Gladys F. Going, Lockie Floyd Carey and Evelyn E.
Floyd, dated February 12, 1927, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 113 at page 172; said
