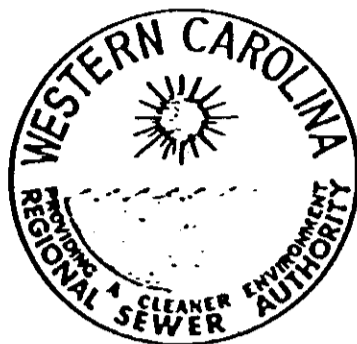

Dear Mr. Thompson:

Enclosed is a letter from J. E. Serrine Company describing plans for development of the Rolling Green Village. This area is located in the Rocky Creek Basin, and flow will be into the Rocky Creek Waste Treatment Plant. As you are aware, we have plans to upgrade this plant by replacing it with a pump station and transferring the waste to the Wade Hampton Plant.

Phase I of this project will result in an estimated flow of 52,000 gpd (design). Current flows at the Rocky Creek Plant since removing the two lift stations in the Devenger area, are well below the design flow. My recommendation is that we accept this flow from Phase I of this project. If you concur, please let us know.
