Dear Mr. Putnam:

We are extremely proud of the fact that you are considering use of natural gas in Rolling Green Village.

At the present time, we are analyzing the area in which a gas main needs to be extended. The preliminary site plan gives us a number of the units planned for the area but does not tell us the square footage of the commercial facilities. We will need further information, as you have it, to figure a rate of return on investment of running the gas main to serve the project.

If the amount of customers is not great enough to extend the gas main, an aide to construction may be required.

Mr. James C. Baker, Jr., District Manager, and the Board of Directors of the Company will need to review all details concerning extending gas to the project before giving you a definite answer on the availability of natural gas.

From available information and assuming we can pick up the majority or all of the heating, water heating and cooking load within Rolling Green, it may be very possible to serve the project. We will do everything in our power to make natural gas available to Rolling Green. When all information that we need to figure rate of return has been compiled and analyzed, then we can provide a definite response.
