III of Davidson County Tennessee own an
interest in the real property described as follows:

ALL that certain piece, parcel, and lot of land lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the western side of Cox Street, and according to a plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 110 at page 101, having the following metes and bounds to-wit:
