year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six, and in the Eleventh
year of the Independence and Sovereignty of the United States of America Be-
tween Patty Prince of the District of Ninety six Spartanburgh County
and State aforesaid of the one part and Thomas Ferrar of the District, County
and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Patty Prince
for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & fifty pounds Sterling
money of the said State hath granted bargained sold aliened released con-
firmed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien Re-
lease convey and confirm unto the said Thomas Ferrar in his actual
possession now being by Virtue of a bargain and sale to him thereof made for a
whole year by an Indenture of lease bearing date the day next before the date
of the date of these presents and by force of the Statute for transferring uses into
actual possession and to his heirs and assigns forever. All that plantations
tract of land containing five hundred and fifty acres situate lying and
being in the District of Ninety six to the west of the Road on the waters of the
Golden Grove East of the Road on the Waters of Reedy River between
Land Bounding North Eastwardly by Moody's land Westwardly by
William Miller's land South Westwardly by Ricca's land South Eastwardly by Naca
