This Indenture made the twenty fourth day of November in the year of one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and in the Eleventh year of the Independance of the united States of America, Between Hance Black of the State of South Carolina Greeneville County planter of the one part and Henry Linderman of the County and State aforesaid Weaver of the other part Whereas in and by a Certain grant bearing date the fifth day of June one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and in the Eleventh year of the Independence of the united States of America from and under the hand and seal of William Moultrie Esqr governor and Commander in Chief of the said State and the great Seal of the said State for that purpose appointed did give and grant unto the said Hance Black a plantation or tract of land containing two hundred and twenty acres situate lying and being in Greeneville County on the pigeon Roast Branch the Waters of Reedy River above the ancient boundary line bounding North East by Mathew Armstrong his land and other sides vacant when surveyed and ^{hath} such shape form and marks as appears by a plat to the said grant annexed as in and by the said plat and grant duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office in the said State in Book L.L.L. page 93. Reference thereunto had more fully appears NOW this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Hance Black for and in Consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Henry Linderman the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged he the said Hance Black hath bargained, sold, aliened, Remised, Released, Conveyed, and Confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, alien, Remise, Release, Convey and Confirm unto the said Henry Linderman in his actual possession, now being by virtue of a bargain and sale to him thereof made for one whole year and by force of the Statute for transferring of uses into possession and to his heirs and assigns forever all the
