This Indenture Made the twelfth day of December in the year of one thousand seven hundred and eighty six and in the Eleventh year of the Independence of the united America, Between Benjamin Rice of Greenville County and state of South Carolina Planter of the one part and Edmund Edwards of the County and state aforesaid planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Rice for and in consideration of the sum of twenty Shillings Sterling money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Edmund Edwards at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Benjamin Rice hath bargained and sold and by the presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Edmund Edwards all that Plantation or tract of Land containing Seventy and three acres more or less being and lying in the County aforesaid on the waters of the Golden Grove Creek a branch of Saluda River it being part of a tract of Land containing four Hundred acres granted unto the said Benjamin Rice by his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esq. Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the said state, bearing date the fifteenth day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty four and in the ninth year of the Independence of the united States of America, Together with all and singular the houses, out houses, Cellars, Buildings, Barns, Stables, yards, Gardens, Orchards, Woods, underwoods, Timber, and Timber trees, meadows, Pastures, Ponds, Lakes, Fishings, Ways, Waters, and Watercourses, Paths, Passages, Liberties, Privileges, Profits, Hereditaments, Rights, members, and Appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the Reversion and Reversions, Remainder
