Bishop of Ninety six District Greenville County of the one part and
Daniel Ford of the same place of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in
consideration of the sum of One Milling and six Pence Current money
of the said State, to him the said Abner Bishop in hand paid at and
Before the sealing and Delivering of these presents the Receipt where
of he doth hereby Acknowledge him the said Abner Bishop hath bar-
gained and Sold and by these presents, doth bargain and sell unto the
said Daniel Ford his Executors Administrators and Assigns all that
Part of a tract of Land containing three hundred and thirty Acres, Situate
Lying and on both sides of the Reedy fork of Reedy River Ninety six Dist.
in Greenville County, Bounded by Mary Burns Land and Co. Winn's
Land, Granted to Abner Bishop by the States Letters Patent, under
the hand of William Moultrie Esquire the then Governor, bearing date
the fifth day of June 1785. and hath such shape form and marks as the
Plat thereof Directs to the Original Grant thereof Annexed, Together
with all and singular that part of said tract containing by Estimation One
Hundred and sixty five Acres be the same more or less Beginning on a blue
Black oak on a line the said tract from thence S 60° along the said line
to the corner a stake. from thence N 60° 20' 20 chains 50 links to a Red oak
corner. from thence N W 60° 22 chains to a post oak corner. thence N E 30°
42 chains to the corner a Sourwood, thence N W 60° along this line to
a post oak corner, agreed on. from thence along a line of marked trees
to the Beginning, The Ways, Wells, Water, Water Courses, Casements, pro-
fits, Commodities, Advantages, Emoluments, and Hereditaments, and
