This Indenture made the Eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six Between Major Pajson and Elizabeth his wife of Senety six District in the state of South Greenville County of the one part, & John Thomas Senr. of the District, State and Country aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Major Pajson and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Pounds current money of said State, to them the said Major Pajson and Elizabeth his wife in hand well and Truly, paid by the said John Thomas the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Major Pajson and Elizabeth his wife, hath granted, Bargained, sold, Alien'd, Released, Conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth Grant, Bargain, Sell, Alien, Release, Convey and confirm unto the said John Thomas, his heirs and assigns forever, in his actual possession now being, a tract of land containing two hundred acres, the same being Part of a certain tract of six hundred and forty acres of land that was granted to the said Major Pajson under
