This Indenture Made the Eighth day of March in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Seven and in the Eleventh year of our Independence Between John Collins of the State of South Carolina Ninety Six District and Spartanburgh County of the one part, and Hugh Warran Senr of the State and District of new and Greenville County of the other part, Whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date the twenty first of January one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty five from under the hand of his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esquire Governor for the time being and the great Seal of this State for that purpose appointed did give and grant unto John Collins a tract of two hundred and five acres of land the same being more or less situate lying on both sides of South Pygar River and hath such shape marks Butting & Boundings as appears by a plat to said Grant annexed the said Plat and Grant being duly Recorded in the Secretarys office

Witnesseth that the said John Collins for and in consideration of the sum of one Hundred pounds Current money to him the said John Collins in hand well and truly paid, the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John Collins hath Granted Bargained and sold, and by these presents doth Grant Bargain, and Sell, unto the said Hugh Warran his heirs and assigns, all that Tract above mentioned of two Hundred and five acres of Land, Together with all Houses out houses Trees, Woods, Underwoods, Tithes, Commons, and Common of Pasture, Ways, Watercourses, Profits Commodities, Advantages, Hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever, to the said tract above mentioned Belonging or in anywise Appertaining, and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders, Rents Issues and Profits of the said Premises, and every part and parcel thereof, and all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest Claim and Demand of him the said John Collins of in, and to the said tract of two hundred and five acres of Land and Premises, and every part thereof, To have and to hold the said tract of two hundred and five acres of Land and all and singular other the Premises above mentioned, and every part and Parcel thereof, with the Appurtenances, unto the said Hugh Warran his heirs and assigns forever, and he the said John Collins for himself, and his heirs the said Tract of two hundred and five acres of Land and Premises, and every Part thereof, against him and his heirs and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever to the said Hugh Warran his heirs and assigns, Shall and will warrant and forever defend by these Presents.
