




This Indenture Made the twelfth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and in the twelfth year of the sovereignty and Independence of the united States of America Between David Brown of Ninety six District and state aforesaid of the one part, and David Lovell of Ninety six District and state aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said David Brown for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings Sterling money of the said state to him in hand well and truly paid by the said David Lovell at and before the Sealing and Delivery of these presents, the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged, hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said David Lovell, his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns all that plantation or tract of land containing two hundred & Eight acres, Situate in the District of Ninety six on the Branches of Arroy River and Branches of Armstrongs Creek butting and bounding to the S W on Col James Hawthorns land, to the S E and Eastwardly on Joseph Box land, and on all other sides on vacant land at the time of the original survey thereof being made which said plantation or tract of land was Granted to the said David Brown by his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire by Grant bearing date the fourth day of December one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and such shape forms and marks as plat to the original Grants annexed Represents.
