 and every part thereof, and all Deeds, Evidences, Escripits, and wri-  
 tings whatsoever, touching or Concerning the same premises, and  
 of every part thereof, To have and to hold the said plantations or  
 Tracts of land containing in the whole seven hundred and Eighty  
 nine acres, with every the premises and appurtenances, thereunto  
 belonging, herein before Granted, Released and Conveyed, unto the said  
 William Himmelwright his heirs and assigns, and the said Thomas  
 Lewis forever: to the only proper and absolute use and behoof of the  
 said William Himmelwright his heirs and assigns; and he the said  
 Thomas Lewis doth hereby, for himself, his heirs Executors, Admi-  
 nistrators and assigns, Covenant, promise, and agree, to and with  
 the said William Himmelwright his heirs and assigns, in manner  
 and form following that is to say, that he the said Thomas Lewis, now is,  
 and untill the execution of these presents, shall stand seized of a  
 Good sure, perfect, and Indefeasible Estate of Inheritance, in fee  
 simple, of, and in all the aforesaid plantations or tracts of land,  
 with the rights, members and appurtenances without any  
 manner of Condition, Trust, Mortgage, Judgment, Execution, or  
 Incumbrance whatsoever, to alter, Change or Determine the  
 same; and also that the said William Himmelwright his heirs  
 and assigns, shall and may from time to time, and at all times here-  
 after peaceably and Quietly, have, hold, use, occupy, possess and  
 Enjoy the said plantations or tracts of land containing in the  
 whole seven hundred and Eighty nine acres, with every the  
 premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging, without any  
 manner of Trouble, Hindrance, Molestation, Interruption and  
 Denial of him the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and assigns

and all and every other person or persons whatsoever; and lastly the  
 said Thomas Lewis, for himself, his heirs, Executors and Administra-  
 tors, the said plantations or tracts of land containing in the whole  
 seven hundred and Eighty nine acres, with the premises and appur-  
 tenances, unto the said William Himmelwright his heirs and af-  
 signs, against him the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and assigns  
 and all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will

 Himmelwright to Thomas Lewis for seven hundred and Eighty nine  
 acres of land. Acknowledged in open Court by the said Himmelwright  
 and ordered to be Recorded

This Indenture made the Eighteenth day of February in the year  
 of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight, and of the  
 Independence of the united States of America the twelfth, Between  
 William Himmelwright of the state of Pennsylvania and City of Phi-  
 ladelphia Cooper, of the one part, and Thomas Lewis of the state  
 of South Carolina and Greenville County (Clerk of said County  
 Court) of the other part, Whereas the said William Himmelwright  
 is, and standeth Justly Indebted unto the said Thomas Lewis in the  
 several Sums of money in the whole Five hundred pounds Sterling  
 money upon two Bonds Entered into by the said William Himmel-  
 wright, to the said Thomas Lewis, Conditioned for the payment of  
 the said several Sums, of Five hundred pound in the whole, on the  
 twenty fifth day of December in the year of our Lord one Thousand  
 seven hundred and Eighty Eight. In consideration thereof, and as well  
 for the better Securing, and more sure payment of the said Sum
