This Indenture made the Twenty fourth day of June in the year of  
 Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight and Twelfth of  
 American Independence Between Alexander M. Elhancy of the State of  
 South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part and William  
 D. Thomas of the State and County of said of the other part Who  
 as in and by a certain grant bearing date the sixteenth day of  
 July 1784, under the hand of his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esquire  
 Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the said State having the  
 great seal of said State thereunto affixed for that purpose appointed,  
 Did give and grant unto said Alexander M. Elhancy a tract of two  
 hundred acres of land Situate on the north side Saluda River, in  
 said County, including the mouth of Checharoa River, having such  
 form and marks as appears by a plat to the said Grant annexed,  
 said being duly recorded in the Secretarys Office in Book L. I. I.
