South Carolina Greenville County August the Eighteenth One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight. A deed of conveyance for two hundred acres of land from William Russell's William Silversides and William Goodwin, acknowledged in open court by the said William Russell and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this seventeenth day of August in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight. Between William Russell of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the one part, and William Silversides and William Goodwin both of the county and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesses that the said William Russell for and in consideration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling to me in hand paid. The said William Russell hath Bargained and sold and by these presents doth Bargain and sell make over and convey unto the said William Silversides and William Goodwin their heirs Executors and Administrators One Certain Tract or parcel of land Containing two hundred acres be the same more or less being part of a Tract of six hundred and forty acres Originally Granted to the said William Russell and bearing date the fifth day of June One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Six lying and being on both sides of Enorce River and Mountain Creek and including the land whereon said William Silversides and William Goodwin now lives said tract of two hundred acres of land lying as followeth Beginning at a Chesnut Russels Station on his lower line on the bank of Mountain Creek and Running twenty Eight poles along said line on the south side said Creek to a black oak from thence Crossing the Creek at the head of the Slitting Swamp at a black oak, from thence up the Creek near to a meadow to a Red oak Station tree on the upper line from thence Running with said line the Various Courses the beginning which said two hundred acres of land more or less is now duly Granted Released and Remised unto the said William Silversides and William Goodwin with all Gardens Houses and appurtenances thereunto belonging together with the Rents Issues thereof To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of land and premises above mentioned with
