South Carolina This Indenture made
the Twenty seventh day of October in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine and
in the Thirtieth year of the sovereignty and Independance
of the united states of America Between Thomas Calla-
way of Burke County in the state of North Carolina
Yeoman of the one part and Robert Maxwell Esquire
of Greenville County in the state of S^c Carolinas of the
other part Witnesseth that for & in consideration of five shil-
lings sterling Money of the said state to him the said
Thomas Callaway in hand well & truly paid by the s^d
Robert Maxwell at and before the sealing and delivery of
these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth
bargain and sell unto the said Robert Maxwell his heirs
Executors & assigns all that plantation or Tract of land
containing four hundred acres more or less lying and
being in Greenville County in ninety six & state of s^c
on the branches of the Golden Grove Creek and Saluda
River bounding to the N & E on lands surveyed for Joseph
Rus and John Myer to the Eward on land surveyed Robert
Maxwell & ward on the said Robert Maxwell's land and
Vacant land all other sides on Vacant land Granted to
the said Thomas Callaway on the Twenty first day of
January Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred &
Eighty five Witness his Excellency Benjamin Guerard
Esquire Governour and commander in chief in and over
the said state which may fully appear in the secretary's
