

43 The following Bill of sale from Thomas Lewis to Vincent Davis was proven before John Alexander Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Gershom Kelley produced in Open Court July Term 1791 and ordered to be recorded which was done this 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1791

I Thomas Lewis of the County of Greenville & state of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina for an in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds paid by Vincent Davis of the County & state aforesaid hath bargained and sold unto Vincent Davis his heirs & assigns for ever the following Articles now in his possession To wit, Two feather Beds and furniture one Chest and the Books &c contained therein to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the S<sup>r</sup> Vincent Davis his heirs and assigns for ever and do hereby agree for myself my heirs Executors and Administrators do and with the said Vincent Davis his heirs and assigns the said bargained premises to warrant and for ever defend by these presents witness my hand this sixth day of May 1791

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Ford to William Smith was proven before John Alexander Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Daniel Ford presented in Open Court and ordered to be recorded which was done this 22<sup>nd</sup> August 1791

This Indenture made this      day of      in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety between John Ford of the District of Ninety six and Greenville County of the one part and William Smith of the District aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Ford for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five pounds lawful Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said William Smith at and before the sealing and Delivery of these presents
