The following Deed of Conveyance from James
 McElroy to Frederick Brock was produced in
 Open Court and proven by the Oath of Jesse Carter
 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done 27th Oct. 1791

This Indenture made the 25th of February
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
 and ninety one and in the sixteenth year of the
 Independance of the united States of America
 Between James McElroy of the State of S. Carolina
 and Ninety six. District of the one part and Frederick
 Brock of the State and District aforesaid of the
 Other part, Whereas in and by a certain Grant
 bearing date the fifth day of June one thousand
 seven hundred and Eighty six it being the Tenth
 year of the Independance of the united States of
 America from under the hand of his Excellency
 William Moultrie Esq. Governor for the Time being
 did Give and Grant unto James McElroy a Tract
 of three hundred and nine acres of Land situate
 in the District of Ninety six. above ancient Bound-
 ary Line on a small Branch of Needy River Sanders
 Branch and on the North side of Needy River Includ-
 ing the West side of Paris's Mountain having such
