The Following Deed of Conveyance from Edward Ballinger to Isaac Gray was proven before Robert W. W. Esq^r by the Oath of James Wheeler and Recorded this 27th Day of December 1791

This Indenture made the first day of September A seventeen hundred ninety and one and in the sixteenth year of the Independance of America Between Edward Ballinger of the state of South Carolina Greenville County planter of the one part and Isaac Gray of Laurence County and state aforesaid planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edward Ballinger for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand well and Truly paid by the said Isaac Gray at or before the sealing and delivring of these presents the Receipt where of the sd. Edward Ballinger doth hereby acknowledge he the sd. Edward Ballinger hath Granted Bargained Sold aliened and Confirmed and by these presents doth Grant Bargain & sell alien and Confirm unto the said Isaac Gray his heirs & assigns for ever a Certain Tract of Land Containing one hundred & ninety five acres of land be the same more or less it being a part of a Tract of Land of five hundred & eighty seven acres Granted to the said Edward Ballinger by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor and Commander in Chief in & over the S^t. State
