This Indenture made this seventh day of February 1792 in the year of our Lord one thousand one thousand seven hundred and ninety Two Between James Blasingame of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina & County of Greenville of the one part & John Blasingame of the state & County of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Blasingame for & in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds lawful sterling money to him in hand paid by the said John Blasingame at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted Bargained sold aliened Released & confirmed by these
