

The following Deed of Conveyance from Nicholas Darnall to Charles Benson being proven before James Blasingame Esq^r by the oath of Abraham Bradley, was produced in Open Court Feb^y Term 1792 and ordered to be recorded which was done 22nd Feb^y 1792

This Indenture made the ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety one and in the sixteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independance of the united State of America Between Nicholas Darnall of Tomleton County & State of S^c Carolina of the one part, and Charles Benson of Greenville County of the other part and state aforesaid Witne^{ss} both that for & in consideration of thirty pounds Sterling in hand paid to the s^d Nicholas Darnall by the s^d Charles Benson before the signing and delivery hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the s^d Nicholas Darnall hath hereby bargained sold and conveyed unto the before mentioned Charles Benson a certain tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less situate in Greenville County on a branch of Lady's River, being part of a Tract of land granted to Nicholas Darnall on the fourth day of July one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Six by his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire containing three hundred & four acres Butting and bounding Northwardly on lands belonging to William Maston and Southwardly on lands belonging to the said Charles Benson and Westwardly on the Road a conditional line made by the s^d Nicholas Darnall and Charles Benson Together with all & singular the woods Waters profits commodities Hereditaments
