


The following deed of Conveyance from Aaron Evans to Moses Evans was proved before George Salmon Esq^r by the oath of Benjⁿ James & presented in Open Court May Term and ordered to be Recorded which was done this 19th day of July 1792.

This Indenture made the eighteenth day of April one thousand seven hundred & ninety two between Aaron Evans of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part, and Moses Evans of the County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Aaron Evans for and in consideration of the sum of eighteen pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Moses Evans the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof exonerate and acquit the said Moses Evans his heirs &c. he hath granted bargained & sold aliened Enfeoffed conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff convey and confirm unto the said Moses Evans all that Tract of land and plantation containing by computation fifty acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the
