152 The following deed of conveyance from Richard Kelley to Benjamin Johnson being proven before George Salmon Esq^r was produced in open Court May Term 1792 & ordered to be recorded which was done 27th July 1792

This Indenture made the first day of February one thousand seven hundred & ninety two, Between Richard Kelley of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part and Benjamin Johnson of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Kelley for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Johnson the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & thereof exonerate and acquit the said Johnson his heirs &c. hath Granted Bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed conveyed and Confirmed, and by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff convey and confirm unto the S^r Johnson his heirs & assigns for ever all that Tract of land and plantation containing by computation fifty acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the County aforesaid on the North side of the middle fork of Saluda River on bounding Mill Creek joining the land of S^r Kelley's and Vacant land, being part of a Tract or survey Originally Granted to said ^{Rich^d} Kelley and Bounded as followeth, Viz, Beginning at a post oak thence N. 43 E 30 Chain to a black Oak thence near an East course about 10 or 12 chains to a Branch thence down said Branch to the mouth thence on an agreement line to S^r Kelley's open line thence to the Beginning with their & every of their rights members & appurtenances to the S^r Benjamin Johnson to the only proper use benefit & behoof of him his heirs and assigns for ever with the reversion, & reversions, remaind^o
