

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The following deed of Conveyance from William Nelson to
Henry Langford was produced in open Court & proven before
Robert Maxwell Esq. by the oath of Josiah Kennedy & ordered to be
Recorded which was done this 4th January 1793.

This Indenture Made Twentieth Eighth day of December
one thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the fifteenth year of the
Independency of America between William Nelson of Greenville
County & State of S. Carolina of the one part & Henry Langford
of the aforesaid County & State of the other part Witnesseth
that the S. William Nelson for & in consideration of five
hundred pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid at or
before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt
thereof is hereby acknowledged & that the S. William Nelson
hath bargained sold & released & confirmed & by these presents
do grant bargain & release unto the S. Henry Langford his heirs
and assigns a Tract of land containing one hundred acres more or
less as the case may be containing in the following lines being
part of a Tract of land granted to Richard Good by his Excellency
Benjamin Guvards Esq. & dated 21st January 1785
Recorded in the Secretarys Office Book C.C.C. page - situate
lying and being in Ninety six district North of Saluda River
