by these presents do make constitute Ordain and
Appoint my Trusty & faithful son John Goode of
Rutherford County North Carolina my True and
lawful Attorney for me, in my name & to my use
to ask demand recover & receive of the Estate of
Joseph Gill Sen^r Deceased wherever to be found
or as much thereof as will satisfy me for the
Contents and demands of a bond I put into his
hands, giving and by these presents granting to
my said Attorney my sole and full power &
Authority to take pursue and follow such legal
Courses, for the securing recovery, receiving
Obtaining & keeping of the same as I myself
might or could do were I present, & upon the
Oath of the same Acquittances or other sufficient
discharges for me and in my name to make
sign seal and deliver, confirming whatsoever my
said Attorney shall lawfully do in and about
the Execution of the premises by Virtue of these
