

207 The following Deed of Conveyance from Isaac Green to John
Simmons was proven before Robert C. Waples Esq. by the oath
of John Anderson proctor in Open Court & May Term
1798 & Ordered to be recorded which was done 24th May 1798
This Indenture made this Eighteenth day of Febru-
ary in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and ninety Two between Isaac Green of Greenville County
& State of South Carolina of the one part & John Simmons
of the state & County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Isaac Green for and in consideration of the
sum of one hundred pounds Sterling Money to him the said
Isaac Green in hand well & Truly paid by the s^r. John Simmons
the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged he the s^r. Isaac
Green hath Granted bargained sold a lined released con-
veyed & Confirmed, and by these presents doth Grant bargain
sell, alien release convey & Confirm unto the said John
Simmons his heirs and assigns for ever in his actual
possession now being a Tract of one hundred acres of
Land be the same more or less lying and being on Moun-
tain Creek a Branch of Enoree River principal part whereof
except six acres was Originally Granted to John Tate by
a Grant under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie
Esq. Governor & Commander in chief of South Carolina &
the great seal of the state. the same as appereth date the first
day of January one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven
and duly recorded in the secretarys Office of said State
in Book 2222 page 386 situate lying & being in Green-
ville County on both sides of Mountain Creek beginning at
a small branch that runs into Mountain Creek below
Benjamin Whortons old field & running from thence S. E.
to a red oak Corner, thence N. E. to a stake, thence N. W. to
a stake thence S. W. to Mountain Creek thence down said
Creek and Meanders to the mouth of the aforesaid small
Branch, thence up the same to the beginning including the
plantation whereon the said John Simmons now lives
