 County of the one part & Isaac Morgan of Greenville County
 Washington District & State aforesaid of the other part Witness
 that the s^d Hughes for & in consideration of the sum of fifty
 pounds Sterling in hand paid by the said Isaac Morgan
 the receipt whereof by the said Joseph Hughes doth hereby
 acknowledge hath given granted bargained & sold by these
 presents doth give grant bargain & sell make over deliver
 & confirm unto him the said Isaac Morgan his heirs &
 assigns for ever one certain Tract or parcel of land situate
 also lying & being in Greenville County Washington District
 on the waters of muddy river joining on Thomas Jenkins
 Land containing three hundred & Seventy Acres Bounded on a
 stake thence N 66^o forty Chains to Dogwood thence
 North East 24 degrees Eighty Chain to red Oak thence South
 East 66 degrees 40 Chains to a stake thence South West 24
 degrees to the first Station being one half of a Tract of 640
