

The following Deed of Conveyance from Henry Pearson to Noble Johnston was proven before John Thomas Junr Esquire produced in Court May Term 1793 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 27th day of May 1793

This Indenture made the third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Ninety Two Between Henry Pearson of Greenville County State of South Carolina of the one part, & Noble Johnston of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the s^r. Henry Pearson for & in consideration of the sum of ten pounds Sterling Money to him the said Henry Pearson in hand well & truly paid by the s^r. Noble Johnston the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Henry Pearson hath granted bargained sold aliened released conveyed & confirmed, & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release convey & confirm unto the said Noble Johnston his heirs & assigns for ever in his actual possession now being a certain Tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation thirty Acres be the same more or less situate lying & being in
