

The following deed of conveyance from James Blasingame to Blackman Ligon was proven before Larkin Tarrant Esquire presented in Open Court May Term 1793 & Ordered to be recorded which was done this 27th day of May 1793.

This Indenture made this tenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one Between James Blasingame Esq.^r of the County of Greenville & State of South Carolina of the one part, & Blackman Ligon of the said County & State of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Blasingame Esq.^r for & in Consideration of of the sum of Thirty pounds Sterling lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Blackman Ligon at & before the sealing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged has granted bargained sold aliened released & confirmed & by these presents do grant bargain sell & confirm unto him the said Blackman Ligon his heirs & assigns for ever Two hundred & Thirty Acres of land more or less lying on Saluda river Opposite Millers Shoals being part of a large survey Surveyed by Thomas Lewis Bounded as follows, To wit, by the land of William Paines & a sb. survey, & by the land of Daniel McKinney's & by Saluda River Together with all Singular the Trees waters hereditaments rights members Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of land & premises hereby bargained sold & belonging or in any wise appertaining & the recessions & provisions remain-der & remainders unto & heirs & assigns thereof To have & to hold the said parcel or Tract of land & premises hereby bargained sold & convey of their Appurtenances unto the said Blackman Ligon his heirs & assigns to his & their only proper use & behoof absolutely for ever & lastly the said James Blasingame Esq.^r doth hereunto set his hand & Seal the day & year first above written
