232 The following Deed of Conveyance from Moses Wood to William Whaley being proven before John Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> was presented in Court May Term 1793 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 1793.

This Indenture made the ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two and in the seventeenth year of American Independance between Moses Wood of the State of N. Carolina & County of Greenville planter of the one part, & William Whaley of the State & County aforesaid planter of the other part Whereas that in & by a Certain Grant bearing date the twenty first day of January one thousand seven hundred & Eighty five under the hand of his Excellency Benj<sup>m</sup> Guillard Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor of said State having the great seal of the state thereunto affixed did give & Grant unto the said Moses Wood a certain Tract of four hundred acres of land, situate in ninety six District above the ancient boundary on both sides of the South fork of Teggur river having such form & marks as appears by a plat to the said Grant annexed which plat & Grant being duly recorded in the Secretarys Office of said State reference therunto here makes it more fully appear & Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Moses Wood for & in consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Current Money of said State to him in hand paid by the said William Whaley before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have Granted bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the said William Whaley all that said Tract or parcel of land Lying without the Rays lines except apart which has been already conveyed to John Jones of said Survey Together with all the houses buildings, woods under woods ways waters water courses hereditaments & appurtenances unto the said parcel of land belonging or in any wise appurtenanting & the reversion
