

216 The Following Deed of Conveyance from John Savage
to John Ferguson ^{Magistrate} being proven before Robert M. Esq. Esq.
was presented in Court May Term 1798 and Ordered to be
Recorded which was done this 3^d day of June 1798

This Indenture made the first day of December Anno
Domini one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight in
the sixteenth year of the Independence of the United States
of America between John Savage of the State of South
Carolina & County of Union of the one part & John Fergu-
son Hammett of the State aforesaid & County of Greenville
of the other part whereas in the certain Grant bearing
date the fifteenth day of October Anno Domini 1784 in
the ninth year of the Independence of the United States of
America recorded in Grant Book T. B. T. Page 300 under
the hand of his Excellency Benjamin Guillard Esq. Governor
& Commander in Chief in & over the State aforesaid & the
great seal of the State for that purpose appointed did give
& grant unto John Savage a Tract of land containing Two
hundred & thirty five Acres of land situated in the District
of ninety six & County of Greenville Ten both sides of rocky
river having such Shapes forms & marks as are represented
by a plat unto the said Grant annexed as in & by the said
plat & Grant duly revised in the Secretarys Office of S. State
reference being thereunto had may more fully appear now
This Indenture witnesseth that the said John Savage for
consideration of the sum of Eighty pounds current money
of the State aforesaid to him in hand paid by the said John
Ferguson Hammett the receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained & sold by these presents do bargain & sell unto
the said John Ferguson Hammett & his heirs & assigns for
ever all that Tract of land containing Two hundred & ~~thirty~~
~~thirty~~ thirty five acres it being all that Tract of land above
mentioned now in the possession of the said John Ferguson
Hammett and also the Tract of land aforesaid is bounded
by William Brandons line on the North side & John Dovens
