The following Deed of Conveyance from William Roe to John Goodman was presented in en Court Shroven May Term 1778 and ordered to be Recorded which was done this 11th day of June 1778

This Indenture made this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and in the seventeenth year of American Independence between William Roe of Greenville County State of South Carolina Ninety ~~and~~ District of the one part & John Goodman of the County & State aforesaid witnesseth that the said William Roe for & in consideration of the full & just sum of forty pounds Sterling him in hand paid by the said John Goodman the receipt whereof he the said William Roe doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth give grant bargain sell & deliver unto the said John Goodman his heirs for ever in fee simple part of a certain Tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County & District above mentioned in South Carolina on the water of McCoy River & Enoree Beginning at a red oak on William Coups line thence South 60th 29 to a Black oak, thence North 30th West to Bonwills line to a Black oak thence North 30th East to a Conventional line to a pine thence west to the line thence to the Beginning containing one hundred & fifty acres of land or less being Originally Granted Joseph Naton and bounded as is above Inserted as may more fully appear by a plat & Grant given to the said Joseph Naton with day of February one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five as appears by record in the Secretarys Office in Grant Book S. S. S. S. page Eighty nine to have & hold the above part of the above granted land with the Appurtenances & hereditaments therunto belonging unto him the said John Goodman his heirs & assigns for ever free & from the above mentioned William Roe from himself & his heirs & from no other person the said William Roe only warrant and defend the said land from him & his heirs for ever with its appurtenances unto him the s^r John Goodman his heirs for ever witness whereof the said
