The following Decree of Conveyance from Richard Kelley to Hugh
McLay was presented in Open Court May Term 1793 and proven
by the oath of Basil Smithson and ordered to be Recorded
which was done this 11th Day of June 1793.

This Indenture made the Twentieth fifth Day of September
one thousand seven hundred and ninety two and in the six-
teenth year of the Independence of the United States of America
Between Richard Kelley of Greenville County of the one part
and Hugh McLay of the other part Witnesseth that the said Rich-
ard Kelley for & in consideration of the sum of thirty one pounds
Sterling to him in hand paid by the said McLay at and before
the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened
Enfeoffed conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell alien Enfeoff convey and confirm unto
the said Hugh McLay his heirs and assigns for ever a certain
Tract or parcel of land lying situate in the County of Green-
ville and State of South Carolina District of Washington on
the Middle fork Saluda surveyed for Richard Kelley the thirty
first day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty four
