

29th The following Deed of Conveyance from John Clayton to William ^{Gasly} was proven before Samuel Earle Esquire produced in Open Court May Term 1798 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 15th day of June 1798

This Indenture made this Twenty third day of June one thousand seven hundred and ninety Two and in the sixteenth year of American Independence between John Clayton of Greenville County and Washington District of the one part & William Gasly of the District and County aforesaid of the other part; whereas in and by a certain grant bearing date the fifth day of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety one from under the hand of his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esquire Governor & Commander in and over the State of South Carolina and for that purpose appointed did give and Grant unto John Clayton a certain Tract or parcel of land containing nine hundred and Twenty five acres be the same more or less situated and lying on both sides of middle Sugar river and hereunto annexed the said plat and grant being duly recorded in the secretarys Office for the said John Clayton to wit that the said John Clayton for the consideration of Twenty pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he now hereby acknowledged the said John Clayton hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto William Gasly his heirs and assigns the plantation or part of the above mentioned Tract of land containing Two hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less beginning at a pine corner supposed to be James Varners running S 45 N 46 Chain across the river to a red oak thence S 18 West 44 chain 78 links to a red oak thence N 79 West 46 Chain to a post oak thence N 10 East 47 Chain to a post oak thence South 82 E 13 chain to a red oak thence N 19 E 10 chain and five links to a black Jack thence S 52 E till it intersects the Course with the beginning line from thence to the beginning together with all and singular the woods water profits commodities or in any way appertaining to have & to hold the said parcel or Tract of land containing Two hundred and fifty acres hereby
