of the State of Carolina and Greenville County for and in
consideration of the sum of seven pounds Sterling Money
to me in hand paid by Bradford Camp of said State & Laurens
County at and before the sealing & Delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have assigned
Transferred & set over and by these presents do assign Transfer
and set over to the said Bradford Camp one feather Bed &
furniture thereunto belonging also two Bedsteads, also the
furniture of one more Bed, also one Iron pot Dutch Oven &
one Skillett, also six Chairs, one table, two Smoothing Irons
also six pewter plates Two Basons & Two Dishes, six knives &
six forks on Chert, one Case & Bottles, one flowered pine box
one pole ax, one Crumbling Hoe, & Two Bread Axes, one small
Broad Ax, one Spinning Wheel, and the said Harris Mullins
do make over all my right Title Interest Claim & demand
whatsomever of in & to the above mentioned Articles & consideration
to the said Bradford Camp his heirs Exors Admrs & assigns
and do warrant and for ever defend the said Articles from
me my heirs Admrs & assigns to the said Bradford Camp
his heirs &c. to stand good in Law and in Testimony and
Notification hereof I do set my hand and affix my seal
the fourth day of July 1793
