314 The following Deed of Conveyance from Thomas Means to William Choice being proven before Parkin Sorvant Esq.^r was presented to the Office and Recorded this 16th Aug^r 1793 State of South Carolina This Indenture made the 19th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Two Between Thomas Means of Fairfield County & State aforesaid on the one part and William Choice of Greenville County on the other part Whereas the said Thomas Means being seized in the right of his wife in fee simple of a certain plantation or Tract of land Containing three hundred acres situate lying & being in the district of Ninety six on a branch of Saluda River and bounded Sth on land laid out to John Mann and on all other sides on Vacant land (when surveyed) which said Tract of land was Originally Granted to Sarah Milling (now wife of the said Thomas Means, on the 21st Day of January 1785 and hath such further & other descriptions as by the Original Grant reference thereunto had will more fully & at large appear
