Miller being proven before Rob^t. Maxwell Esq by the oath of
Michael Henderson was Recorded this 16 Day of Aug^r 1793
This Instrument made the fifteenth day of April one thou-
sand seven hundred and ninety three between Isaac James of
Greenville County South Carolina of the one part and David Miller
of the County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the
said Isaac James for & in Consideration of the sum of ninety
pounds Current Money to him in hand paid by the said Miller
before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the Receipt where-
of is hereby acknowledged, he the said Isaac James hath Grant-
ed, bargained, sold, aliened Confeffed Conveyed and Confirmed
and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell alien Confeff
Convey & confirm unto the said David Miller & his heirs for ever
a certain Tract or parcel of land containing three hundred & two
acres More or less Situate lying and being in the County aforesaid
on the Beaver Dam Creek of Saluda Beginning at a pine st-
thence N.E. 10^o 50 Chains to a light wood Stake 3^d thence N.E. 80^o
33 Chains to a Pecory 3^d thence S.W. 10^o 14 Chains to a Black oak
3^d thence N.E. 75^o 10 Chains to a Black oak 3^d thence S.E. 70^o
