Charles Allen was presented in open Court May Term 1794 and
proven by the oath of Thomas Edwards and ordered to be Recorded
which was done this 26th day of May A.D. 1794

This Indenture made this Third day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Ninety four in the
eighteenth year of American Independence Between Joseph
Langston of the State of N. Carolina Greenville County Washington
District of the one part & Charles Allen of the said County dis-
trict State of the other part; Whereas by certain Grant bearing
date the fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred & Eighty six from under the hand of his Excellency
William Moultrie Esquire Governor & Commander in chief in &
over the state aforesaid having the great seal of the State hereunto
affixed being for that purpose appointed did give & Grant unto
Joseph Langston a plantation or Tract of land containing six
hundred & forty acres situated lying in Greenville County
Washington District & on Langstons Branch a Branch of
