Mosley being presented before Larkin Tarrant Esq. by the
Cath of Jeremiah Stokes was Recorded this 4th June 1794
This Indenture made the fourteenth day of April in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
ninety four and of the Independence of the united States
of North America the eighteenth between John Paul of
Greenville County & State of South Carolina of the one
part, and Samuel Mosley of the County & State aforesaid
of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Paul for sin-
consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling to
him in hand paid by the said Samuel Mosley, the receipt
whereof the said John Paul doth hereby acknowledge he
the said John Paul hath granted bargained and sold aliened
and confirmed, and by these presents doth Grant bargain
and sell alien and confirm unto the said Samuel Mosley his
heirs and assigns for ever a certain trail or parcel of land con-
taining Twenty acres be the same more or less situate and
lying in Greenville County & State of South Carolina being
part of a Trail of land containing three hundred forty five
acres Granted to William Varnel from under the hand of his
Excellency William Moultrie Esq. the then Governor by Grant
bearing date the fourth day of September one thousand seven
hundred and eighty six and recorded in the Secretaries Office
