

The following Deed of Conveyance from David Peden & wife to
Ezekel Henderson being proven before James Harrison Esq.
by the oath of James Cooper was Recorded 19th June 1794
South Carolina This Indenture made this ninth day
of October, and in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand
seven hundred and eighty eight Between David Peden of
the said State and County of Greenville of the one part, and
Ezekel Henderson planter of the same place of the other part
Witnesseth that the said David Peden for and in considerati-
on of the sum of forty pounds lawful Sterling Money to him
in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these
presents by the said Ezekel Henderson, the receipt whereof
the said David Peden both hereby acknowledgeth & sheweth & of &
from every part and parcel thereof, do acquit & discharge the
said Ezekel Henderson his heirs and assigns, and for divers other
good causes and considerations hereunto moving have granted
bargained sold aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these
presents do bargain sell, enfeoff and confirm unto the said
Ezekel Henderson his heirs and assigns for ever all that Tract
of land lying and being in ninety six district and Greenville
County and on Rocky Creek a branch of Rudy River, containing
one hundred & fifty seven acres and part granted to the said David
Peden and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the fifth
day of June 1786 as by the said Grant & plat annexed thereto will
fully appear Together with all and singular the Houses ways
waters, paths passages Trees fences enclosures Hereditaments
