489 The following deed of conveyance from Moses Wood to Margaret Wood being proven before Robert Mape Esq. by the oath of Mr. Armstrong was Recorded this 21<sup>st</sup> June 1794 State of South Carolina This Indenture made this seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and in the seventeenth year of the Sovereignty of the Independence of the united States of America between Moses Wood of the aforesaid State and County of Greenville planter of the one part and Margaret Wood of the aforesaid State and County of Greenville Lady of the other part Witnesseth that the said Moses Wood for and consideration of the full and just sum of ten pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Margaret Wood the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Margaret Wood her heirs Exors. admors. and assigns for ever in fee Simple a Tract of seventy acres of land it being part of a Tract of land granted to the aforesaid Moses Wood containing four hundred acres situate in Ninety six district above the Antient boundary line on South Tygar River bounded on the N E by Jeremiah Duttons land on the N W by Robert Nelsons land and all other sides vacant land Originally granted to the said Moses Wood in the year one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five and
