504 The following Deed of Conveyance from William Doble to James
Dillingham being proven before George Salmon Esq. by the
oath of John Young was recorded this 28th July 1794

This Indenture made the Twenty seventh day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
Ninety four Between William Doble of Spartan County and
State of South Carolina Iron Master of the one part, and
James Dillingham of the County & State aforesaid of the
other part Witnesseth that the William Doble for and in con-
sideration of the sum of Sixty pounds Sterling Money to
him the said William Doble in hand well and truly paid
by the said James Dillingham the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged he the said William Doble hath granted bargained
sold, aliened conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents
doth grant bargain sell, alien convey and confirm unto
the said James Dillingham his heirs and assigns for ever
in his actual possession now being all that plantation tract
or parcel of land containing Two hundred acres be the same
more or less Situate lying and being in Greenville County
and State aforesaid on both sides of Mush Creek, waters of
Spar River Beginning on a Chesnut on on the west side said creek
Running thence North twenty degrees West fifty chains to a Hy-
cory Stake thence South seventy degrees West forty chains to a
Red oak, thence South twenty degrees East fifty chains to a
