

I know all men by these presents that I Enoch Hooper of  
Greenville County State of South Carolina, for and in  
consideration of the sum of eighty pounds Sterling money  
of South Carolina to me in hand paid by Samuel Earle  
of the County & State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do  
hereby acknowledge, have bargained, sold, & delivered  
and by these presents do bargain sell & deliver unto the  
above named Samuel Earle, a certain Negro Fellow  
Harry to have and to hold the said Negro fellow Harry  
unto the said Samuel Earle his Executors, Administrators  
and assigns to his & their only proper use and behoof  
for ever, and I the said Enoch Hooper my Executors and  
Administrators the said Bargained premises unto the  
said Samuel Earle his Executors Administrators & assigns  
from and against all persons, shall and will warrant  
and for ever defend by these presents. — Provided always  
and it is hereby covenanted, concluded, & declared and  
agreed by & between all and every the said parties to these  
presents, and the true Intent and meaning of them and of  
these presents, is that if the said Enoch Hooper his heirs or  
assigns do & shall well & Truly pay or Cause to be paid unto  
the said Samuel Earle where he now lives the Just & full  
sum of Eighty pounds Sterling Money, on or before the first
