

The following power of Attorney from Maximilian Corner to John Young
 Just. being proven before George Salmon Esq. by the oath of W. Young
 was presented & Recorded this 13th day of January 1795
 State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that S. Maxi-
 millian Corner of Franklin County & State of Georgia do make Ordain
 constitute & appoint John Young Just. of Spartan County & State of South
 Carolina my true & lawful attorney to sell dispose of & convey to any
 purchaser or purchasers a tract of one thousand acres of land or any
 part thereof Situate in Greenville County & State of S. Carolina on
 both sides of Reedy Fork of Reedy River bounded Northwardly on George
 Martins land Eastwardly on William Woods land & Southwardly on
 S. Maximilian Corner's land ratifying & confirming whatsoever
 my S. Attorney may do concerning the premises as much as if I
 were personally present & to sign conveyances in my name for the same
 or any part thereof with power of Substitution In Witness whereof
 the S. Maximilian Corner has hereunto set my hand and
 affixed my seal the tenth day of February one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety four

The following Deed of Conveyance from James Vernon to Elisha Dew-
 ese being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq. by the oath of Peyton
 Nowlin was presented & Recorded this 14th day of January 1795
 This Indenture made this tenth day of August one thousand seven
 hundred & ninety three & in the seventeenth year of American's Independ-
 dence between James Vernon of the State of South Carolina & Ninety
 six District of the one part, & Elisha Dewese of the S. State & Washington
 District of the other part Witnesseth that the S. James Vernon for & in
 consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds Sterling money to
 him in hand paid by the S. Elisha Dewese at & before the sealing & delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof he the S. James Vernon doth
 hereby acknowledge & from every part & parcel thereof do acquit and
 discharge the S. Elisha Dewese him & his heirs & assigns & for divers
 other good causes & considerations hereunto moving have granted
 bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed & by these presents
 do grant bargain convey & confirm unto him the S. Elisha Dewese
 his heirs & assigns for ever part of a plantation or tract of land lying
 & being in the District of Washington & Greenville County & on Reedy
 River Originally granted to Alexander Vernon on the twenty first day
 of January Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & eighty five
 as by a plat hereunto annexed will fully appear beginning on and oak
 St. thence N 60 E 7.00 to and oak St. thence S 90 E 19.80 to a Hickory St. John
 Camps land thence N 60 E 44.75 to a post oak St. Hewitt Sullivan's land
 thence N 10 W 7.75 to a stake St. Charles Sullivan's land thence S 75
