Isaac Cox his heirs & assigns forever one hundred acres of land more or less lying in Greenville County on Reedy River being part of a tract of two hundred acres of land Originally Granted to Michael Purkle & signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the third day of April one thousand seven hundred & eighty six & in the tenth year of the Independance of America as by a plat annexed to the s^d. Grant will more fully appear being laid out unto the s^d. Isaac Cox as follows beginning on a red oak which stands in the line of the above mentioned tract of two hundred acres on the North bank of Reedy River from thence running N^o 50^o on the s^d. line to a post oak corner from thence running N^o 40^o to Christopher Robins line from thence running on the s^d. Christopher Robins line to the s^d. Reedy River from thence running down & bounding on the middle of s^d. Reedy River to the beginning Including one hundred acres of land more or less together with all & singular the houses out houses ways waters paths passages trees fences easements hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the s^d. tract of land so described as above belonging or in any wise appertaining & the reversion & reversions, remainder & remainders unto Issues & profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof & all the estate right title Interest claim & demand whatsoever both in Law & equity, of him the s^d. James Samford of in & to the same premises & of in & to every part & parcel thereof to have & to hold the s^d. parcel or tract of land & all & singular other the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the s^d. The following Deed of Conveyance from Uriah Corner to James Seaborn being proven before John B. Briggby Esq. by the oath of Larkin was presented & Recorded this sixteenth day of January 1795
 This indenture made the twenty eighth day of January thousand seven hundred and ninety five in the thirteenth year of the Independency of America between Uriah Corner of Franklin County & State of Georgia of the one part, James Seaborn of Greenville County & State of South Carolina of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d. Uriah Corner for & in consideration
