Robert Gilliam doth hereby acknowledge & of & from every parcel thereof do acquit & discharge the S<sup>d</sup>. Charles Pope his heirs & assigns & for divers other good causes & considerations hereunto moving do grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the S<sup>d</sup>. Charles Pope his heirs & assigns for ever all that plantation or tract of five hundred acres of land situate in the
