This Indenture made this thirteenth day of August in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred & ninety four between Samuel Gordon of the
 State of South Carolina & County of Greenville of the one part & William Subb
 of the County & State afo^r. Witnesseth that the S^r. Samuel Gordon hath for the
 consideration of the sum of five hundred pounds to him in hand paid by
 the S^r. William Subb unto the S^r. Samuel Gordon hath granted bargained &
 sold & by these presents doth bargain sell & confirm the same unto the said
 William Subb his heirs Ex^{ors} & Adm^{rs}. & assigns a certain tract or parcel of
 land containing six hundred acres be the same more or less & hath seen
 shape form mark butting & bounding viz, Beginning on a Black oak on
 the South side of Enoree River thence N 40 E 40 chain thence N 75 E 25-50
 to a stake thence N 30 W 37-80 to a Black oak corner thence S 81 W 82-70 to
 a Black oak thence S 10 E to a poplar a Conditional Corner between Sam-
 uel Gordon & Young Griffin, thence with the Meanders of the Meadow to
 a post oak, thence Crossing the River to a Black oak on a path thence up the
 path to a Spanish Oak thence to the beginning situate in the District of
 Washington on Enoree River west of the Indian Boundary line Surveyed
 for Obadiah Hooper & by him sold to S^r. Gordon reference to the Record of
