

Blasingame the receipt whereof is whereby acknowledged he the said Isam Clayton & Comfort Clayton hath granted bargained sold conveyed & confirmed to the said John Blasingame his heirs & assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred & eighty acres more or less lying and being in Greenville County on the north side of Saluda beginning on a Black oak running thence N 95 E 31 till it strikes the Creek and up the main Creek to the fork then up the left prong that runs to Isam Claytons Spring till it strikes the Original line to a Black oak thence S 70 E 32 to a Chesnut thence S 25 N 37 to a Black oak from thence N 50 to a Lin tree on Saluda together with every appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appurtenant to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Isam Clayton for himself & his heirs the said tract of land as above described against him the said Isam & Comfort Clayton their heirs and assigns for ever shall and will warrant & for ever defend by these presents unto the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns from all and every other person or persons whatsoever laying any claim thereunto In witness whereof the said Isam & Comfort Clayton hath whereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day & year first above written

The following Deed of Conveyance from Benjamin Perry to Hugh Carter being proven before Nath. Perry Esq. of Pendleton County by the oath of Purcell Whithead was presented & Recorded this 16<sup>th</sup> March 1795  
This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four between Benjamin Perry of Pendleton County in the State of South Carolina of the one part and Hugh Carter of Greenville County <sup>the</sup> State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of seventeen pounds in hand paid to the said Benjamin Perry by the said Hugh Carter the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Ben<sup>a</sup> Perry hath hereby bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said Hugh Carter a certain tract of land containing four hundred acres (more or less) situate in Greenville County on the long branch waters of Needy River butting & bounding on all sides on vacant land at the time of the Original survey thereof being made and hath such shape and marks as a plat thereof to the Original Grant annexed represents being first Granted to Esther Thomas by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq. on the seventh day of November one thousand seven hundred and eighty five together with all the waters woods profits com modities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto
