Hooper being proven before Blasingame Esq. by the oath of Charles  
Benson was presented and Recorded this 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1795  
This Indenture made the thirteenth day of January in the  
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two & in  
the sixteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independance of the  
United States of America between William Benson of Spartan-  
burgh County & State of South Carolina of the one part & Enoch  
Hooper of Greenville County & State aforesaid of the other part wit-  
neseth that for and in consideration of fifty pounds Sterling  
in hand paid to the said William Benson by the said Enoch Hooper  
before the signing and delivering hereof the receipt whereof is  
herby acknowledged the aforesaid William Benson hath hereby  
bargained sold and conveyed unto the before mentioned Enoch  
Hooper a certain tract of land containing one hundred & forty  
three acres situate in Greenville County on the North side of Sa-  
luda River being a tract of land granted to William Benson on  
the third day of December one thousand seven hundred & eighty  
seven by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esq. containing one  
hundred and forty three acres butting and bounding Southwardly  
of Enoch Hoopers land on the North side of Saluda River adjoining  
the said Hoopers land & Paul Fountain & Josp Logan land together  
with all and singular the woods waters profits commodities here-  
ditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging  
or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said tract  
of land containing one hundred and forty three acres hereby  
granted and sold with their and every of their appurtenances  
unto the said Enoch Hooper his heirs and assigns for ever &  
the said William Benson for himself his heirs Ex. Adm. &  
assigns the said hereby bargained premises with their appur-  
tenances unto the said Enoch Hooper his heirs and assigns shall  
and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents
