The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Blasingame to Thomas Casley being proven before Th<sup>s</sup> Blasingame Esq by the oath of John Macbeth was presented and recorded this 9<sup>th</sup> June 1795 This Indenture made the fourteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five Between Thomas Blasingame of Union County State of South Carolina of the one part & Thomas Casley of the County of Greenville State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas Blasingame for an in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand well and Truly paid by the said Thomas Casley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Thomas Blasingame hath granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell convey & confirm to the said Thomas Casley his heirs & assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred acres more or less lying and being in Greenville County on a branch of Branch Creek & a branch of Saluda River beginning on a red oak S 90 E to a post oak S 70 W to a post oak N 60 W to a post oak N 20 E to a post oak then to the beginning corner together with every appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the only proper use and behoof of him the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Casley his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Thomas Blasingame for himself and his heirs the said tract of land as above described against him the said Thomas Blasingame his heirs & assigns for ever shall warrant and for ever defend by these presents unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Casley his heirs & assigns from all and every other person or persons laying any Claim thereunto In witness whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Blasingame has set his hand & affixed his Seal the day and year first above written Signed Sealed In the presence of
