The following deed of Conveyance from Samuel Gordon to young Griffin being proven before John Blackwell Esq^r by the oath of John Anderson was presented and Recorded this 17th day of June 1795

This Indenture made this Eleventh day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between Samuel Gordon of Greenville County of the one part & Young Griffin of the County aforesaid of the other part Witneseth that for in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds Sterling in hand paid by the S^r Young Griffin to the said Gordon the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said Samuel Gordon hath hereby bargained sold and conveyed unto the said Young Griffin one certain Tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation Sixty acres of land be the same more or less bounded as follows beginning at a corner pine of Robert Princes land from thence along that line across the Enace River to a corner poplar the said Gordon made thence down the Meanders of the Meadow to a post oak corner Tree, thence along a new line across the river to a road, that goes from the said Gordons to the said Griffins and then corners on a red oak, thence along the road to a corner Spanish oak and from thence to the beginning Together with all woods waters profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have & hold this Tract of land hereby Granted Sold with their and every of their
